Project Overview

This fall TCHFH will be starting our Heights Development. The first group of projects will include single family homes (7) and twin homes (6) for a total of 19 housing units. All 19 units will be awarded to a single contractor for each separate type of work available for bid. For example, there will be a single plumbing award & contract that covers all 19 units.

Bid Process

- Twin Cities Habitat for Humanity is operating as both the Developer and General Contractor at the Heights Development.
- One sample plan for each model type (5 total) will be provided for bidding with supplemental documents as needed for requested option costs. Designated sample models have been called out above, on the bid notification, and on the map of site.
- Bid forms are required and are due at 5:00 PM on August 30.
- Workforce Projection forms are to be completed and submitted with bid forms.
- Bid results will be provided to all bidders after the awards are completed.

Requirements

Please see the compliance overview and zipped documents folder in the bid documents for additional details about the requirements below.

- General liability insurance and workers compensation insurance.
- Required contract provisions including: Suspension and Debarment; Equal Employment Opportunity; Minority Business Enterprise; Women Business Enterprise; and Drug Free Workplace. Twin Cities Habitat for Humanity is an equal opportunity employer, and as such, businesses owned by women or minorities are strongly encouraged to bid.
- Affirmative Action Plan Any subcontractor that has been awarded with \$50,000 or more worth of contracts funded by City of St. Paul over the previous twelve months will be required to register an affirmative action plan.
- Workforce Employment Goals Each subcontractor is expected to do their best to help Twin Cities Habitat for Humanity meet or exceed the workforce employment goals.
- Little Davis Bacon/Prevailing Wage with online certified payroll submittals.
- Project Labor Agreement with the St. Paul Building & Construction Trades Council applies to this project. Union membership is not required for bidders, but all bidders must comply with labor agreement regardless of their union status. This agreement includes required contributions to established employee fringe benefit funds regardless of union status.
- Developer/general contractor (TCHFH) vendor outreach goals for engaging minority-owned, womenowned, and small businesses registered through the Central (CERT) Certification Program. Certification is not required, but preference may be given to certified companies if needed to meet vendor outreach goals. Subcontractors will be required to verify payment information via the City of St. Paul's B2Gnow website.
