How to Find Your Legislator

There are two ways to meet with lawmakers:

- **Meet with your legislator at a specific spot.** If you have a **green sticker** on your folder, you have special instructions for meeting your Representative. If you have a **red sticker**, you have special instructions for meeting your Senator. This means you might meet before lunch time or at a specific location. Check the flip chart to see when and where you are meeting, which might include the Senate or Centennial Building.

OR

- **Pull your legislator from the floor.** After lunch, find your district group and head to the area outside the chambers, then pull your lawmaker from the floor.
 - To pull your lawmaker from the floor, submit a note to your lawmaker requesting to meet briefly to discuss affordable homeownership.
 - Keep your district number cards visible so they or their legislative assistant can find you!
 - Wait for your legislator to come out. If they haven't come out within 30 minutes they might be unable to, and you can always follow up with a letter or email!

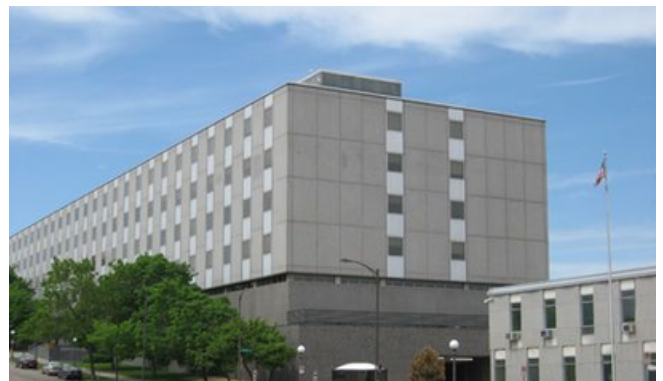
Then repeat this process for your other lawmaker!
