- 2,000 families have achieved homeownership.
- Thousands improved their finances and living conditions through home repairs, financial coaching, and foreclosure prevention counseling.
- Hundreds of thousands of community members have been part of this mission as clients, volunteers, donors, advocates, board members, staff, AmeriCorps members, and partners.

Your legacy goes beyond numbers. It shows up when a teenager celebrates her high school graduation in a safe, stable home her parents own, or when a father builds wealth to pass on to his children. Your legacy echoes through the Capitol when advocates rally together for a more equitable community.

Habitat for Humanity International's legacy began at Koinonia Farm, an interracial community where farmers lived, worked, and broke bread together in rural Georgia during the Jim Crow era. Their commitment to equality continues to inspire our focus on racial equity in the Twin Cities.

Building The Heights

Progress continues at The Heights development in St. Paul's Greater East Side, Twin Cities Habitat's largest development ever.

With your help, we're transforming the former Hillcrest golf course into a new sustainable community that will include 147 Habitat homes.



Summer 2024

Excavation work began on the larger site, which will include 1,000 units of mixed-use affordable housing, employment opportunities, and public amenities. Foundations were laid on the first two of four blocks of Habitat homes, making Twin Cities Habitat the first developer to start building at *The Heights*.



Winter 2025

Work continues after thousands of volunteers launched the first 30 Habitat homes during the 2024 Jimmy & Rosalynn Carter Work Project in October. Roofs are on, garages are in progress, all units have heat and power, and volunteers are currently working on the 2-unit townhomes and single-family homes.

Spring 2025 & Beyond

"I'M LIVING IN THE MIRACLE I PRAYED FOR!"

You might meet Michelle running karaoke on Friday nights at the Wayzata American Legion. Or if you are lucky enough, you will get to taste her amazing cooking-like the flan her friends rave about.

She has a job she loves, she is becoming healthier than she has ever been, and she makes you feel right at home when you visit.

If you ask what made it possible for Michelle to build this beautiful life for herself, a key ingredient is her home. Her safe, stable, affordable Habitat home.

Since buying her affordable Habitat home, Michelle is giving back. She volunteered every day during the 2024 Jimmy & Rosalynn **Carter Work Project.** Your support is the gift that keeps on giving!



Michelle always loved singing and found solace in music. She attended the High School for Performing Arts in Manhattan and performed at Carnegie Hall and Lincoln Center. She dreamed of becoming famous, but the next part of her life felt like it happened fast.

"I was eighteen when I met the man who would become my husband, nineteen when I got married, and twenty when I had my son. I had not even figured out who I was yet," Michelle remembers.

She moved numerous times while pursuing music and raising her son. "Not all places were 'livable,'" she remembers.

There was the studio apartment with a yellowjacket infestation and black mold. There was the small room she rented from a couple in a toxic relationship. Other times, she was forced out by rising rents.

At the beginning of 2020, Michelle decided to make a change. A cousin invited her to move into her home in North Minneapolis. She found a job she loved, began saving and earning promotions at work, and started looking for homes.

After a few setbacks, Michelle found Twin Cities Habitat's Homeownership Program. It was just what she needed. To her delight, Michelle found a Habitat home that would be built just a block from where she was living with her cousin.

Michelle visited her future home often. She saw walls going up and rooms taking shape. And before she knew it, Michelle was at the closing table. But receiving her keys didn't make homeownership feel real yetit came later, with those small things that turn a house into a home.

"Handing out Halloween candy with my porch decked out for the first time, throwing a Friendsgiving... Something about celebrating those first few holidays just made it so much more real—being in a place where I can have people over."

Another thing that made Michelle's home feel more real was when she got sick. Michelle has dealt with health challenges throughout her life, from asthma to sustaining a concussion. It felt impossible for her to feel fully

rested while living in someone's cold, clammy basement, or while living with someone who played loud video games late into the night.

Now, in her own home, Michelle can have the peace and quiet she needs to fully recover and take care of herself.

"I'm living in the miracle I prayed for," Michelle remembers, emotion creeping into her voice. "How many people get to say that?"

"Please keep giving and volunteering your time. Your generosity is what moves us from stressful households into peaceful homes."
